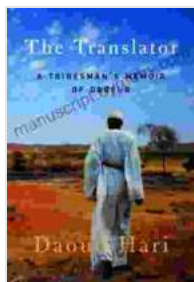

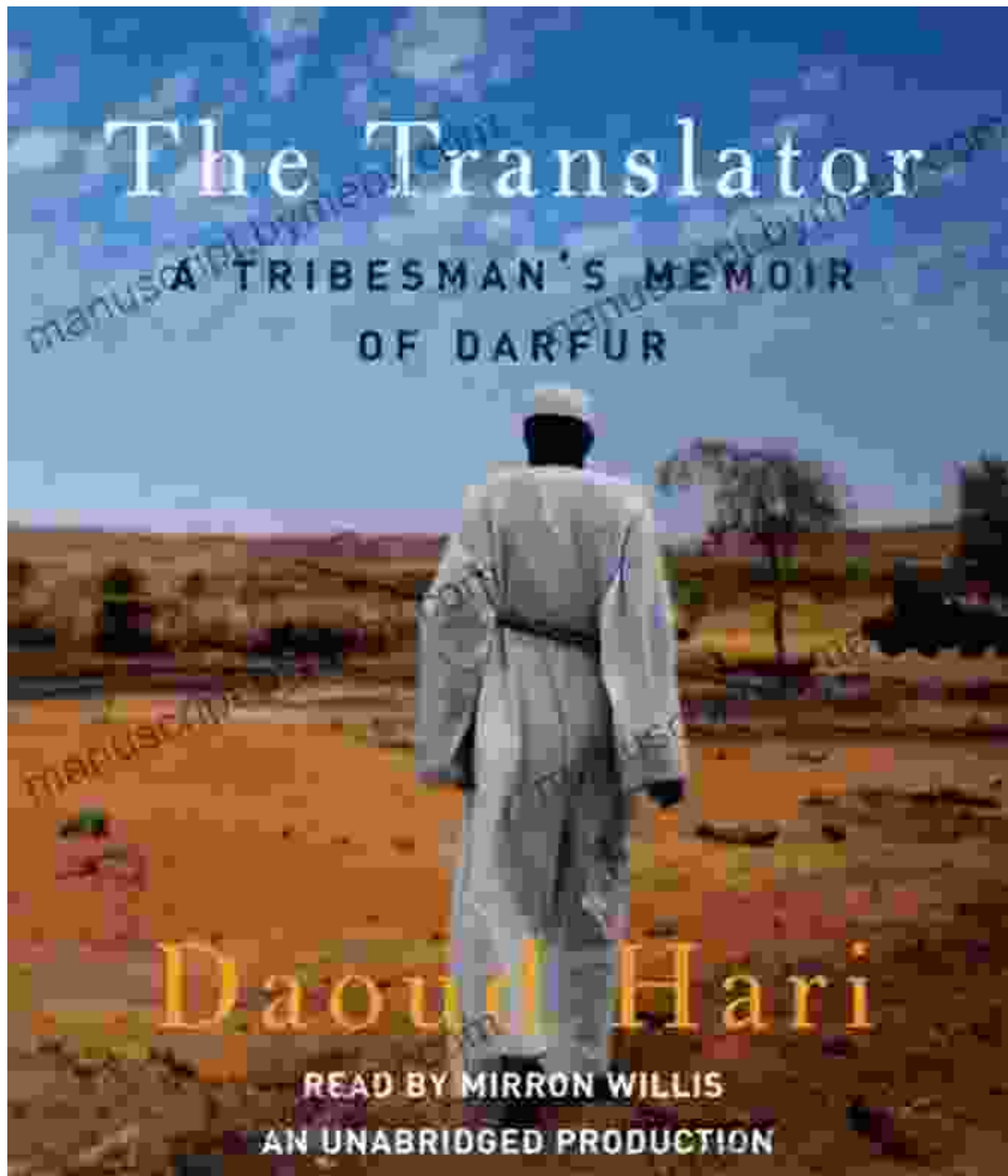

Hari is currently living in the United States. He is married and has two children.

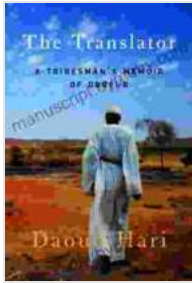

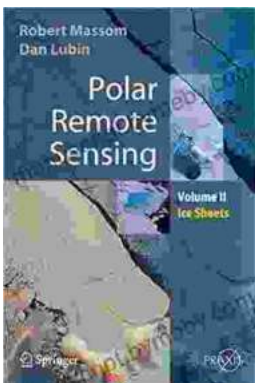

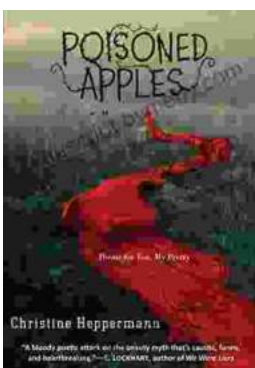
